



Dear Babysitter!

Thank you so much for giving up your time and energy to take care of this beautiful place while we are away. We know you will love it here as much as we do! Please contact Clare and Jay on 0438066817 with any questions/queries.

Please check the list of tasks that we have left for you. Do not feel bad if you don't get through them all though. We are a workplace, there are some hazards you need to understand, and precautions you must take whilst on the property.

Following is some information you need to know before coming to Wollangarra. Please read, print it off, sign it and bring it with you when you come.

Flying Fox

- If you have never been here, please do not attempt to enter Wollangarra unless accompanied by a current staff member. Please ensure you arrive to have a handover with the staff.
- Please do not attempt to enter, nor allow visiting friends to use the Wollangarra fox after dark.

Front Paddock

- The access track in the front paddock is strictly for Wollangarra vehicles driven by a current staff member only.
- Please park your vehicle outside the gate on the Heyfield-Licola Road.

Vehicles/Tractor/Chainsaws/Mowers/Whippersnippers/Brushcutters/Pumps/Power tools

- Please do not use or attempt to use any of these items whilst at Wollangarra.
- Wollangarra has a no power tool policy. Please do not bring power tools into Wollangarra.

Pets

- We have a very protective alpaca, which will kill dogs that chase sheep. Bring pets at your own risk.
- If you do bring a pet, please do not allow it inside the homestead, nor store any pet food in our refrigerators. Our kitchen is commercially certified, and as such, no food other than "fit for human consumption" may be stored.
- Please collect any pet droppings from around the homestead and either bury or deposit without a plastic bag in the toilets.

Rubbish

- Please take all of your rubbish and recycling with you when you leave. Please don't put your rubbish in our rubbish trailer, as it costs us money each time we go to the tip.

General Hazards (not an exhaustive list)

- Venomous snakes and spiders
- Goannas
- Deep, fast flowing water
- Nails, screws, wire, sharp blades
- Debris
- Trip hazards, uneven, steep terrain
- Manual handling
- Falling tree limbs

Please note: all staff and director bedrooms and residences are private and are off limits. We ask you to respect this privacy.

We recommend you have ambulance cover, we are in a remote location, it's a long way to the hospital.
